

## **FTP Access to your SUNYIT Directory and Web Publishing**

Every faculty, staff and student has the ability to create a website or post files to be accessed via the Internet. Your website URL will be <http://www.sunyit.edu/~YourSitNetID>.

You can access your SUNYIT web space with any SFTP (secure file transfer protocol) application. Examples include Filezilla, ws\_FTP, WinSCP, Fetch, etc. A majority of the current web development applications like Adobe Dreamweaver have built-in FTP applications for easy uploading and downloading of files.

Regardless of the FTP application, there are three pieces of information that will be required. The Host or Server, a Username or User ID, and a password.

Use the following information to gain ftp access your personal SUNYIT web account:

Host/Server:           ftp.sunyit.edu

Username/User ID:    Your SitNet ID

Password               Your Password/Pin

Port                    22

After you log in, create a folder named public\_html within your folder on the file server. This folder must reside at the top level of your personal folder. (i.e., YourSitNetID/public\_html). Use SFTP to copy your files into your public\_html folder.
